

HEINRICH KRONSTEIN, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

THAT he is forty-two (42) years of age.

THAT he and his wife, Kaste, and their two children, Karl and Werner, aged twelve (12) and nine (9) years respectively, reside at 1825 Fort Stevens Drive, Washington, D. C., and have resided there since August, 1958, having immigrated from Germany in December, 1958, on immigration visas.

THAT he was a practicing attorney in Germany for many years having received the degree of Doctor of Law from the University of Berlin in 1934; that he attended Columbia Law School in the city of New York from which he graduated with the Bachelor of Laws degree in June, 1939; that the degree of Scientias Juris Doctor was conferred on him by the Georgetown University Law School in Washington, D. C., in June, 1940.

THAT he has since March, 1955, acted as an expert in European law for certain attorneys, and particularly for the Department of Justice of the United States, and expects to continue to so act until he becomes a citizen, in which event he has all reason to hope for permanent employment.

THAT since July, 1958, he has earned approximately ^{in 1958} three thousand dollars (~~3,000~~ 3,500) and is able to provide for his family and his father, Abraham Jacob Kronstein.

THAT his father is now residing at Grunstr. 5, Pforzheim, Germany, and is desirous of entering and settling in the United States.

THAT your dependent is anxious to have his father live in his home; that he has sufficient room in his home to accommodate his father; that his family will do everything possible to make his father happy in his old age;

THAT he guarantees that his father shall never become a burden on the United States or any State, County, City, Village or Municipality or any private charitable institution; that he is willing to furnish any bond that may be necessary;

THAT he has received his first papers for American citizenship and expects to become a citizen in February, 1941.
