MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

In regard to the development, operation and direction of the Georgetown Institute for International and Foreign Trade Law for the budget year 1962-1963 until 1965-1966, inclusive, the following has been agreed upon:

1. Professor Heinrich Kronstein as a full member of the faculty shall be in charge of the Institute as its Director.
2. There is to be prepared a three-year budget plan to enable the Institute to obtain a permanent standing and prepare its research and publication program accordingly.
3. It is assumed that the financial assistance of Dr. Shulte zur Hausen is to continue for the entire three-year period.
4. It is anticipated to come to a formal understanding with the Frankfurt Institute regarding the cooperation and common research program between the Frankfurt Institute and Georgetown University Law School.
