I refer to our phone conversation of yesterday afternoon and item 8 of the October 21 memo from Father Henle to Father Fitzgerald.

To help out with the administration, Mrs. Ruof and I will do the paper work on any payments to Dr. Kronstein (and Mrs. Weyersberg); in fact I understand that Dr. Kronstein may in the future be paid entirely in Frankfurt, so that we may only be talking about the \$6,000 and fringe benefits which Mrs. Weyersberg receives outside the Institute budget (she receives \$2,000 plus fringe benefits within it).

We agreed that such payments to Dr. Kronstein and the non-institute component of Mrs. Weyersberg's payments will continue to be paid in the separate account which has already been established, #3-011-686, but that you will see that it will be given a new number in the 3-026 series - separate from the institute's account number.

Thanks for all the help. I enclose a copy of this for Father Fitzgerald, to whom I have also written (copy enclosed) today in reply to his note to me of October 25.
